Co-operatives throughout the world share a set of values that give them their distinctive character.

Co-operative Identity - A Co-operative is an autonomous association of persons, united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly owned and democratically controlled enterprise.

Values - A value can be described as something you believe in and what is important to you in life.

Co-operative Values: Self Help, Self Responsibility, Democracy, Equality, Equity, Solidarity.

Principles - Are guidelines by which co-operatives put their values into practice.

Principles: Voluntary and Open Membership, Democratic Member Control, Member Economic Participation, Autonomy and Independence, Education, Training and Information, Co-operation Among Co-operatives, Concern for the Community.
